

<b><u>EVALUATION OF 2025 GRANT PROPOSALS</u></b>	
<b>ELIGIBILITY</b>	
Does the proposal meet each of these requirements?	<b>(Y/N)</b>
Is the applicant a Loeb alumnus? Does it involve a diverse group of Loeb alumni? If an international application, does it have a domestic sponsor or partner (this enables funding)? If the project has previously won a Loeb Alumni Grant, will the second phase significantly advance the project's goals? Is the application complete? Does it identify an established 501(c)(3) for its fiscal sponsor?	
<b><u>RATING CRITERIA</u></b>	<b><u>SCORE</u></b>
<b>Quality of the Proposal (maximum of 20 points)</b>	
Is the proposal well-conceived, with clear goals?	
Does the budget contain sufficient detail?	
Does it involve co-sponsorships or collaborations with other organizations?	
<b>Potential Community Impact (maximum of 20 points)</b>	
Would it have a direct impact on a community in need?	
Will it catalyze new thinking or breakthroughs within the field?	
Will it significantly advance the project toward completion?	
If a second-time applicant, has the project shown significant learning and evolution?	
Will it reach a wide audience either during the program or activity or afterwards?	
<b>Fellowship Impact (maximum of 20 points)</b>	
Will it foster new collaborations among Loeb alumni from different class years, locations and disciplines?	
Will it increase the visibility of the Loeb Fellowship?	
Is there a well-defined plan for documentation, publicity, and dissemination?	
<b>TOTAL (maximum score of 60)</b>
