1. Introduction

The Script should be written using *Microsoft Office Word (*.doc or *.docx)* single spaced in A4 size letter (210 mm x 297 mm) with top and bottom margins 2,5 cm, left margins 3 cm and right margins 2,5 cm. Use *Times New Roman* 11 pt for the entire script. The text layout should be written using one column with.

The manuscript should be presented in several sections, starting from introduction (25%), methods (20%), Results (30%), Discussion (15%), Conclusion (10%) and references. Introduction consist of background, problems, urgency of the research and the gap that filled by the research from previous results [1].

2. Parts of Manuscript

Contain of several section including framework, research methodology, results and discussion, and conclusion.

2.2 Paragraph

Paragraph should be started with 1 cm spacing for the first line and should be given 1 space line each paragraph.

2.3 Tables and Figures

Tables and figures presented in the center of the script. Tables and figures should fit the columns. If it does not fit the columns, tables and figures should be placed on top or bottom of the page.

2.1 Section

Section is written with corresponding to the section number. The maximum level of section is 3 levels, such as: 2.1.1. Section and section number should be written using Times New Roman 11 pt *bold, justified, title case mode*. To separate one section to another, add 1 space line.
