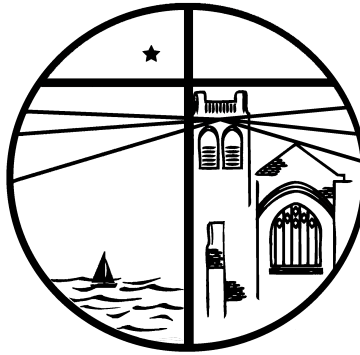

LOCAL SERVICE PROJECTS VOLUNTEER

Overview: A local service projects volunteer supports the church's mission to "continue God's transforming work by worshiping God joyfully, welcoming others graciously, supporting one another lovingly, and faithfully responding to our community and world with compassion." The Outreach Council's mission is "to show Christ's love and compassion for our neighbors by helping with hunger, education, housing, health, and other needs. We strive to support this mission by allocating funds and calling all GPMC members to hands-on action" by participating in any of the many events and donation drives offered by the Outreach Council.

Responsibilities:

- Actively seek out opportunities to volunteer; look in church's bulletin, website, email, on bulletin boards, lobby racks, or Middle Hour presentations
- If requested, use sign-up form to register your intention to participate
- Respond to communication from leaders if any special instructions are offered or special requests are made
- Be confident in your role
- Ensure you are dressed appropriately and have what you need to fully engage without distraction (food, sunscreen, water, tools, etc.)
- Arrive on time, rested, prayerful, and ready to serve
- Be fully present and focused on the people, mission, and your assigned task
- Follow guidelines for cell phone use during the project
- Participate in debrief activities, providing helpful feedback

Relationships:

- Reports to Outreach Council leader or outreach coordinator, who ensures support needed to thrive in this role
- Serves in a relational community with others serving in this project

Time Commitment: Varies depending on project

Special Talents, Skills Preferred: Passion for justice and/or specific populations or causes, mercy, helps, a desire to grow in cultural and emotional intelligence
