State Statutes 120.12 (13), 118.30 (1g) (a) 1

The Adams-Friendship Board of Education shall provide instructional materials and equipment, within budgetary constraints, to implement the District's educational goals and objectives and to meet students' needs. The primary objective of such instructional materials and equipment shall be to enrich, support, and implement the educational program of the school.

The Board does not discriminate on the basis of any characteristic protected under State or Federal law including, but not limited to race, race, color, religion, national origin, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital status, parental status, sexual orientation, sex, (including transgender status, change of sex or gender identity), or physical, mental, emotional, or learning disability or any other characteristic protected by Federal or State civil rights laws ("Protected Classes") in its selection of instructional materials and equipment.
