Learning Targets:

Students will:

- Identify and interpret the standard notation symbols for music
- Recognize whole half, quarter, eighth, eighth note and rest duration in various meters
- Recognize expressive elements of music
- Analyze aural examples of music in terms of basic musical elements and their interrelationships, using appropriate music terminology
- Understand music in relationship to the geography, history, and culture of world civilizations and societies from the beginning of human society.
- Understand the relationships between music and concepts from other areas
- Students will learn the value of contribution to the aesthetic and cultural life of the community.
- Students will use electronic media to enhance the learning experience.
- Students will master global and interpersonal skills necessary to be successful in an open forum.
