On **Tuesday 5th December** we will be taking 6J to visit the Sikh Gurdwara in Leeds as part of our RE topic on Sikhs. During this unit of work, the children will learn about how Sikhs show their commitment to God. They have looked at worship and how sharing with others in the Langar (free Kitchen) is an important part of their beliefs. All these things are done at the Gurdwara, the Sikh place of worship. This trip will help the children see the learning in context and consolidate their knowledge and experience.

We will leave school in the morning at around **9:00 (school minibus and staff cars)** and will return in time for lunch. The children will have lunch at school as normal. The children will have a talk, a tour and then share in the Langar meal, which the people at the Gurdwara will cook. Children will need to remove their shoes once inside for the duration of the trip.
