

Registration Notes for Students:

There is no right way or “better” schedule to earning your LATTA degree. There is a pathway for EVERYONE to earn their Associates degree. The quickest way is to pass your classes and have a balanced EC course. If you struggle with a class or two, it is not the end of the world; we will work to create a pathway for you to continue to work towards the degree.

Current 9th graders - registering for 10th

- Take a minimum of two EC courses *beyond* World History or AP World History (many of you will have more).
- Business Technologies needs to be taken in 10th grade.
- Students not taking Honors Language or Chemistry should take Business Technologies and a minimum of two other EC Electives.
- Those taking AP Human Geography: if you Pass the AP Exam, please log into your College Board Account and send those scores to MCC.

Current 10th graders - registering for 11th

- If you took Chemistry and Honors English 10 and will be enrolled in at least two (3 would be better) of the following courses in 11th grade you are more than on track: Honors World Language, APUSH, PreCalculus, College Algebra, regular yearlong Physics, AP Physics I, or Human Anatomy & Physiology.
- Students who are not taking Honors World Language or APUSH, please enroll in a minimum of three Social Sciences/Humanities/Electives your junior year.
- You should have a minimum of 4 ECHS courses scheduled this upcoming school year; taking more will lighten your senior year.
- If you plan to be a Junior Grad or Early Grad, please begin those conversations with the ECHS office in April to see what your course plan should look like.
- For those who did not take Chemistry and don't plan to take Physics or AP Physics I - Human Anatomy and Physiology is an alternative Early College course that can be used to fulfill the science requirement for the LATTA degree.
- If you did not take Business Technologies this year and are short with credits, try to work it into your schedule if possible. It's a semester long course that can really lighten your load your 12th grade year.

Current 11th graders - registering for 12th

- Congratulations on 2 ½ years of Early College progress. I hope you are proud of yourselves for all that you have accomplished so far and try to finish strong in the next few months. Senior year is just around the corner.
- If anyone intends to be a December Grad next year, please start this conversation with your families and counselors.
- All seniors will enroll in College Writing and Government in their senior year.
- College Writing, College Algebra and US Government are offered as Blended courses that count for ECHS. Note: Blended AP Government does not exist.
- Anyone who has struggled to complete multiple ECHS courses, or 3+ yearly ECHS classes, please come see us in the Early College office located in the library so we can work together to make sure you are on track to meet your educational goals.
- If you have not taken APUSH, any Honors Language courses, or more than 3 Early College elective courses, please come see us in our office ASAP.
- Classes at MCC are TUITION FREE through the summer of 2026! Please contact Mrs. Barona if you're interested in taking a class (or more) directly through MCC.
