1. Immigration and Border Security

- **Securing Our Borders**: Enhances border security measures, including resuming border wall construction and deploying additional troops.
- Realigning the United States Refugee Admissions Program: Adjusts the refugee admissions process to align with new administration priorities.
- Protecting the United States from Foreign Terrorists and Other National Security and Public Safety Threats: Implements stricter vetting processes for individuals from specific countries.
- Protecting the Meaning and Value of American Citizenship: Attempts to end birthright citizenship for children of undocumented immigrants and certain temporary visa holders.
- **Protecting the American People Against Invasion**: Declares the southern border situation an invasion, activating specific executive powers.

2. National Security and Foreign Policy

- Application of Protecting Americans from Foreign Adversary Controlled Applications Act to TikTok: Addresses national security concerns by targeting foreign-controlled apps like TikTok.
- **Designation of Ansar Allah as a Foreign Terrorist Organization**: Classifies the Houthi movement in Yemen as a terrorist organization.
- Designating Cartels and Other Organizations as Foreign Terrorist Organizations and Specially Designated Global Terrorists: Labels specific drug cartels and organizations as terrorist entities.
- America First Policy Directive to the Secretary of State: Directs the State Department to prioritize policies benefiting American interests.
- Reevaluating and Realigning United States Foreign Aid: Reviews and adjusts foreign aid allocations to prioritize U.S. interests.

3. Energy and Environment

- Unleashing American Energy: Promotes domestic energy production by reducing regulations on fossil fuels.
- Putting America First in International Environmental Agreements: Withdraws the U.S. from certain international environmental agreements, including the Paris Agreement.
- Unleashing Alaska's Extraordinary Resource Potential: Encourages resource extraction in Alaska by reducing environmental regulations.

 Declaring a National Energy Emergency: Declares an emergency to expedite energy projects and infrastructure.

4. Governance and Federal Workforce

- Initial Rescissions of Harmful Executive Orders and Actions: Revokes numerous executive orders from previous administrations.
- Restoring Freedom of Speech and Ending Federal Censorship: Aims to prevent federal agencies from engaging in censorship.
- Ending the Weaponization of the Federal Government: Seeks to prevent the misuse of federal agencies for political purposes.
- Restoring Accountability to Policy-Influencing Positions Within the Federal Workforce: Reforms federal hiring practices to emphasize merit-based appointments.
- Reforming the Federal Hiring Process and Restoring Merit to Government Service: Overhauls hiring practices to focus solely on merit, removing diversity considerations.
- Ending Radical and Wasteful Government DEI Programs and Preferencing: Eliminates diversity, equity, and inclusion programs within federal agencies.
- Establishing and Implementing the President's "Department of Government Efficiency": Creates a new department aimed at improving government operations.

5. Healthcare and Pandemic Response

• Withdrawing the United States from the World Health Organization: Initiates the process of withdrawing U.S. membership from the WHO.

6. Civil Rights and Social Issues

- Defending Women from Gender Ideology Extremism and Restoring Biological Truth to the Federal Government: Recognizes only two biological sexes in federal policies, affecting transgender rights.
- Ending Illegal Discrimination and Restoring Merit-Based Opportunity: Rescinds policies related to affirmative action and DEI programs.

7. Technology and Innovation

• Removing Barriers to American Leadership in Artificial Intelligence: Promotes Al development by reducing regulatory hurdles.

- Strengthening American Leadership in Digital Financial Technology: Establishes a framework to enhance U.S. leadership in digital finance.
- President's Council of Advisors on Science and Technology: Reconstitutes the advisory council to guide science and technology policy.

8. Justice and Public Safety

- Holding Former Government Officials Accountable for Election Interference and Improper Disclosure of Sensitive Governmental Information: Investigates former officials involved in election interference.
- Restoring the Death Penalty and Protecting Public Safety: Reinstates the federal death penalty for specific crimes.

9. Historical and Symbolic Actions

- Restoring Names That Honor American Greatness: Reinstates traditional names for landmarks and geographic features, such as changing Denali back to Mount McKinley.
- Declassification of Records Concerning the Assassinations of President John F. Kennedy, and the Reverend Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.: Orders the release of classified documents related to these historical events.
