## Stem-Changing Verbs: e:i

Remember, there are three types of infinitives: -ar, -er, -ir. Infinitives are made up of two parts: the ending and the stem. In the following examples, the stem is **bold** and the ending is in **highlighted**.

AR Verbs	ER Verbs	IR Verbs
habl <mark>ar</mark>	com <mark>er</mark>	viv <mark>ir</mark>
to speak	to eat	to live

With regular verbs, the <b>stem</b> stays the same, and <u>the ending</u>			
changes as they are conjugated.			
Pronoun	HABLAR	COMER	VIVIR
Yo	Hablo	Como	Viv <sub>0</sub>
Tú	Hablas	Comes	Vives
Él, ella, Usted	Habla	Come	Vive
Nosotros/as	Hablamos	Comemos	Vivimos
Vosotros/as	Habláis	Coméis	Vivís

Ellos/as/Uds.	Hablan	Comen	Viven

With some verbs, the **stem** also changes when you conjugate them. In the present tense, there are three groups of stem-changing verbs.

o:ue	e:ie	e:i

With the second group of stem-changing verbs, the letter **e** in the stem changes to **i** in all forms **except the nosotros and vosotros**.

Pronoun	REPETIR (to repeat)
Yo	repito
Tú	repites
Él, ella, Usted	repite
Nosotros/as	repetimos
Vosotros/as	repetís
Ellos/as/Uds.	repiten

Here's another e:ie stem changing verb.		
Pronoun	COMPETIR (to compete)	
Yo	compito	
Tú	compites	
Él, ella, Usted	compite	
Nosotros/as	competimos	
Vosotros/as	competís	
Ellos/as/Uds.	compiten	

Here's another <b>e</b> :ie stem-changing verb. Notice how the stem doesn't change in the nosotros and vosotros forms.		
Pronoun PEDIR (to ask for)		
Yo	pid0	
Tú	pides	
Él, ella, Usted pide		

Nosotros/as	pedimos
Vosotros/as	p <mark>edís</mark>
Ellos/as/Uds.	piden

repetir	to repeat
elegir	to elect
freír	to fry
servir	to serve
gemir	to groan, moan
