Data Confirmation

The Aeries Parent and Student Portal **MUST** be updated annually for current contact information, emergency contact information, household data information (used for funding and student resources), to check on your child's academic progress throughout the school year, and to obtain your child's 2025-2026 teacher and classroom information.

Chromebook Protocol

Students will only be allowed on websites/programs that the teacher has assigned. Students will receive a consequence if students misuse their chromebook. Parents will be provided information at BTSN about how to access and monitor student email.

Dress Code

- Hats may be worn on the playground during recess or P.E. Hats may not be worn in the classroom or the cafeteria. -Hoods are to be worn only for inclement weather.
- -Tennis shoes must be worn for PE.
- No open-toed shoes or shoes with heels everyday.

-Crocs are not permitted during the 25-26 school year.

- -Clothing must completely cover underwear and may not expose mid-section. Spaghetti straps and low-cut tops are not to be worn.
- -Pajamas are not to be worn unless it is a Spirit Day.
- -Students may wear mid-thigh shorts. Students wearing shorts too short will call home for a different pair.
- -Make-up, heavy jewelry, long, fake nails are not to be worn.

Electronic Devices/Personal Items

Cell phones/Smart Watches must be turned off and placed in a backpack during instructional hours. Students can use cell phones off campus before and after school hours.

Toys/Personal Items

Children are not to bring toys, trading cards, or personal items to school unless directed by a teacher or staff member. These items cause a distraction. Please be sure to check backpacks for non-school related items.

No Airpods/Bluetooth earphones are not allowed

Food/Snacks

- -Healthy snacks for morning recess
- -No shareable bags/sharing
- -Any treats provided to whole class must be store bought
- -No soda or energy drinks
- -Gum is not allowed
- -Spicy chips (ie: Hot Cheetos, Takis, etc.) will only be allowed at lunch, not on the playground during recess time/before or after school.

Birthday Treats

Please make sure that you arrange celebrations with your child's teacher FIRST. Unscheduled treats may or may not be given out by the teacher if no prior notice. All goodies and snacks must be store bought. Please be mindful that there may be students with food/nut allergies. Please schedule ahead of time.

Drop off/Pick up

NO TURNER ENTRANCE for ARRIVAL. GATE WILL ONLY BE OPEN AT DISMISSAL

- -One lane open for drive thru loop -Pull up PAST the cone near large gate -Large gate will be open for students to enter at 7:45
- -Students will enter through front gate at 7:30am for breakfast
- -Crosswalk will be used for families who park in the parking lot. **Please do not cross through moving traffic**
- -QUICK drop off/pick up. Please have students near passenger side and ready to exit the car promptly
- -DO NOT Park and leave car in drive thru lane
- -Kindergarten parents-please park and walk students to the gate. Parents will not be able to park and leave cars in the moving drive thru loop.

Attendance/Tardies

Absences must be verified through the office, even if you have contacted the teacher. When your child is absent from school, please call the school office before 9:00 a.m. to indicate the reason for the absences. If you do not contact the office, your child will be marked as unexcused. Any absence lasting more than three days will require a Doctor's note. If an absence is not verified as excusable within ten (10) days, it shall be recorded as unexcused.

Tardies over 30 minutes (tardy great) are recorded as absences. After three absences/tardy great, parents will receive a truancy letter.

Excusable absences- illness, medical appt., funeral of immediate family
