

Workforce Readiness

- Employability skills, along with academic and technical skills, are a critical component of college and career readiness.
- Discussing/documenting employability skills that are embedded in instructional practice helps students to realize the connection between education and employment.
- Opportunities exist for tutors to integrate employability skills in everyday lessons, at every age and in every content area.
- Development of employability skills does not occur in one or two classes, but grows over the course of a student's educational career.
