

## B. Letter Tiles

- **1. Word Building Relay**
  1. **Objective:** To promote teamwork and word formation skills.
  2. **Materials:** Letter tiles, timer.
  3. **Instructions:**
    - Divide the class into teams.
    - Set a timer for 5 minutes.
    - Teams race to build as many words as possible using letter tiles.
    - After time is up, each team presents their words, and points are awarded for unique words.
    - Discuss the meanings of the words created.
- **2. Letter Tile Scrabble**
  1. **Objective:** To develop spelling and vocabulary skills.
  2. **Materials:** Letter tiles, a Scrabble board or grid.
  3. **Instructions:**
    - Set up a Scrabble board or grid.
    - Students take turns placing letter tiles to form words, scoring points based on letter values.
    - Encourage students to use a dictionary to verify words.
    - At the end of the game, discuss the words created and their meanings.
- **3. Word Transformation**
  1. **Objective:** To understand phonetic changes in words.
  2. **Materials:** Letter tiles.
  3. **Instructions:**
    - Start with a base word (e.g., "cat").
    - Students take turns changing one letter at a time to create new words (e.g., "cat" → "hat" → "hot").
    - Discuss how the meaning changes with each transformation.
    - Challenge students to create a list of all the words formed during the activity.
