## ***Requirements and Qualifications for Registration***

### **A. Requirements for Youth Delegates, Youth Observers and Advisers**

1. Duly accomplished Registration Form
2. Clear scanned copy of valid Membership Accident Assurance Benefit (MAAB) ID
3. Endorsement Letter stating that the delegates and observers are duly qualified to participate as specified in the qualifications below, duly signed by the School or Community Head
4. Parental Waiver (for participants aged below 18 years old)

### **B. Qualifications**

#### **1. Delegates**

- A. All incumbent Chapter Youth Council Officers are delegates to the Assembly.
- B. Only accredited councils can send delegates to the Chapter Youth Assembly.
- C. Each Accredited Red Cross Youth Council is allowed four (4) delegates in the Assembly. These delegates shall have voting powers and will elect the next set of Chapter Youth Council Officers.
- D. Delegates shall come from Senior Red Cross Youth, Senior Plus Red Cross Youth, College Red Cross Youth, and Community Red Cross Youth councils.
- E. They shall have the following minimum qualifications:
  - Must have undergone the Youth Volunteer Formation Course (formerly known as Leadership Development Program) of the Red Cross Youth;
  - Must be an active member of an accredited council duly certified by the Council Adviser and School or Community Head;
  - Must have actively participated in Chapter Activities of the Red Cross Youth;
  - Enrolled in the Membership Accident Assurance Benefit of the Philippine Red Cross; and
  - Endorsed by the RCY Council Adviser.

#### **2. Observers**

- Duly accredited and established councils can send observers to the Chapter Youth Assembly.
- Each accredited and established council can send a maximum of four (4) observers to the Assembly. The observers shall not have voting powers but can be present in the proceedings of the CYA.
- Observers shall come from Junior Red Cross, Senior Red Cross Youth, Senior Plus Red Cross Youth, College Red Cross Youth, and Community Red Cross Youth councils.



- An observer shall have the following minimum qualifications:
- Must have undergone the Youth Volunteer Formation Course (formerly known as Leadership Development Program) of the Red Cross Youth;
- Must be an active member of an accredited or established council duly certified by Council Adviser and School or Community Head;
- Enrolled in the Membership Accident Assurance Benefit of the Philippine Red Cross; and
- Endorsed by the RCY Council Adviser.

### 3. Advisers

- One Red Cross Youth Adviser is allowed to participate in the Chapter Youth Assembly.
- The adviser shall be enrolled in the Membership Accident Assurance Benefit, Bronze Membership.

The deadline of the registration shall be on **November 21, 2025**. All necessary requirements and documents (endorsement letters, proof of payment of registration fee, scanned copy of MAAB ID, etc.) shall be received by the Assembly Secretariat on the set deadline at the Philippine Red Cross – Negros Oriental Chapter. No extensions shall be entertained.
