Primary sources and interpretive documents are used to enlighten the time period and promote such critical thinking skills as analysis and evaluation. Comprehension and understanding of global interactions and their impact on nations, people and the world will be heavily emphasized. Students in Honors are expected to personally challenge themselves with a greater degree of responsibility and will be assessed for a deeper understanding of historical content through research, writing, and discussion skills. Additionally, students will be expected to be able to apply the global learnings to the current world around them.
