

DCMS Hybrid Structure Through October 30, 2020

Parents/Guardians,

A continued “rule of thumb” for the hybrid at-home middle school learner is to devote ~20 minutes of time per class period during [Hybrid Learning](#). During the every other day hybrid model, we feel that students need to check-in with all their classes while at home for ~20 minutes each. 5th grade operates in a block schedule so their expectations may be closer to ~30-40 minutes for core classes. ***(~2 hours per day of at-home learning is appropriate for the middle school learner).***

Teachers will consider and plan for activities and meaningful practice assignments that students can accomplish in ~20 minutes for their class, while students are at home.
