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| <p><b>EL Content Area Classes</b></p> <p><i><u><a href="#">Sample schedule</a></u></i></p>                            | <p><b>For students new to the US or in early stages of English language development</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• These are classes designed to <b>help students develop their English skills and their academic skills at the same time.</b></li> <li>• <b>Math, science, social studies (history) and language arts (English)</b> taught by Bilingual Resource Teachers.</li> <li>• Students take the rest of their classes with other English speaking students and participate in the regular life of the school.</li> </ul> |
| <p><b>General education classes with co-teaching support</b></p> <p><i><u><a href="#">Sample schedule</a></u></i></p> | <p><b>For students with intermediate or advanced English language development</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students participate in general classes with the support of a Bilingual Resource Teacher or a Bilingual Resource Specialist who works with the general education teacher.</li> <li>• Working together, while supported by teachers, students access grade level content, skills, vocabulary and academic language needed to be successful in high school.</li> </ul>                                                 |
| <p><b>Dual Language Immersion (DLI) Program</b></p> <p><i><u><a href="#">See linked form</a></u></i></p>              | <p><b>For students whose families speak Spanish at home or students with academic Spanish. <a href="#">DLI Program</a></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Designed to <b>build academic Spanish proficiency</b> and intercultural skills.</li> <li>• Students take a DLI Spanish class and History in Spanish with DLI students, all other classes are in English.</li> <li>• Students can obtain the <b>Seal of Biliteracy and a Bilingual Certificate with their Diploma.</b></li> </ul>                                            |
| <p><b>Monitoring, Support and Consulting</b></p> <p><i><u><a href="#">General Education Schedule</a></u></i></p>      | <p><b>For students who have tested at a high level of English and are no longer receiving English Language services</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Bilingual teachers monitor the academic progress of students for two years.</li> <li>• Bilingual teachers work with general education teachers to advise and consult on working with multilingual students.</li> <li>• If students maintain academic growth for two years, they no longer take the yearly English language test (ACCESS).</li> </ul>                           |
