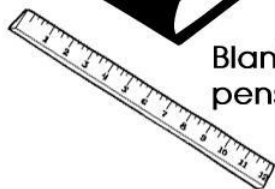

Take responsibility of YOUR education by completing your own work and participating in class.



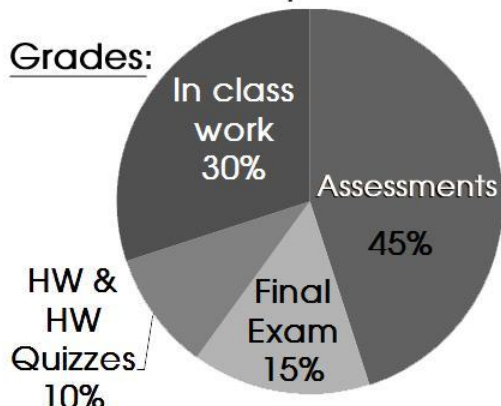
NO cell phones and other electronic devices out in class unless you are told by your teacher it is ok to use them. They will be confiscated if seen and taken to office.
