Sports Premium Grant 2020 - 2021

What is the Sports Premium?

The government is providing new and substantial primary school sport funding. The dedicated primary PE and Sport Premium, which was announced in March 2013, and began the following September, goes directly to primary school head teachers so that they can decide how best to use it to provide sporting activities for pupils.

At Royal Wharf Primary School, we are very much aware of the contribution of PE to the health and well-being of the children. We believe that having access to high quality P.E and sport has a positive influence on the concentration, attitude and academic achievement of all our children. Our Primary School Sports Funding will enable us to enrich our provision through our school sports partnerships, funding training for our staff to deliver high-quality PE lessons, enhancing our extended school provision and keeping our Sports Schemes and Equipment up-to-date.

Previous funding: Royal Wharf Primary School has not previously had this funding as it did not have pupils in years 1 to 6 prior to 2020. For the year 2020 - 2021 the school had 60 Year 1 pupils and no other pupils qualifying for the grant.

Funding for the year 2020 - 2021: £16,600

How did we spend the funding?

Provision: £4,747.50

- Hiring specialist sports and gymnastics coaches to work with our pupils and staff.
- Year 1 Multi sports after school club.

Continuing Professional Development planning resource: £250

Competitive Events: £200 Running sport competitions, or increasing pupils' participation in the School Games. We use the budget to cover the class teacher who attends the sporting events with TAs.

School Sports Partnership: £330 The school subscribes to the local sports partnership organisation which provides a range of development and competitive events.

Sports resources: £1,437.06

Impact: This funding has supported the school's aim to raise the profile of sport and encourage activity for all children. As a result -

- Our pupil break times have a range of exciting activities
- Pupils have the opportunity to engage in activities that aid their stamina and fitness levels
- Teachers and teaching assistants gain CPD through high quality PE and Sports sessions
- Pupils have participated in competitive sporting events

Total Grant spent: £6,964.56

Amount carried forward to 2021/2022: £9,635.44
