This morning, our school was briefly placed on a “hold” as a safety precaution. During this time, students remained in their classrooms and continued instruction as usual, while movement around campus was temporarily paused.

The hold was initiated because an adult visitor in the front office became verbally aggressive, threatened school staff, and used inappropriate language. Our school staff acted quickly and followed district safety procedures to ensure the situation was contained and that students and staff remained safe at all times.

The Buckeye Police Department responded promptly and assisted in removing and trespassing the individual from campus. The situation was resolved quickly, and normal operations resumed shortly thereafter.

At no point were any students or staff in danger. We are extremely proud of our staff and students for responding calmly and following safety protocols.

Please know that maintaining a safe and respectful environment for our students, staff, and families is our top priority. If your child expresses concern or has questions about the incident, please reassure them that the safety measures in place worked exactly as intended.
