 - USA has 17180 active challenge caches, followed by Germany, Canada, Norway, France
 - No change in the Challenge Leader stats Worldwide.
 - However!!! California +13 over Texas!, Michigan -12 behind #3 Florida
 - West Virginia jumped 3 spots, #36 in the list

Challenge Cache Moratorium?!!

A 1 year halt on all challenge cache publishing gave GCHQ time to rework the rules and guidelines for challenge caches. Post-moratorium challenge caches abide by different restrictions than pre-moratorium challenge caches, which have been 'grandfathered' as is.

Moratorium started: April, 2015 Moratorium ended: May 25, 2016
