

**The PSAT/NMSQT® (Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test) is available to 10th- and 11th-grade students.**

#### ***THE PSAT...***

- 1. Provides valuable data. Their focus is on the content and skills learned in the classroom.**
- 2. Links to free, personalized SAT practice through KHAN Academy**
- 3. Identifies skills for improvement**
- 4. Identifies which AP classes a student is likely to succeed at**
- 5. Builds a college-going culture with online college & career planning tools**

6. Juniors are eligible for the National Merit Scholarship Program. Taking the test as a sophomore gives the student a chance to see what the test focuses on and opportunities to practice throughout the year

The PSAT will be towards the end of October with a fee of \$18.00. Complete information will be provided when students are signed up with Mrs. Weiner.
