1. Overview

The “**Quick Feature Selector**” add-on integrates the captcha service into your store to protect your site from bots.

2. Installing the add-on

The installation package will be available for download on the Order detail page.

1. Log in the administration panel and go to the **Add-ons -> Manage add-ons** page
2. Use the **Upload & install add-on** button on the top of the page to install the add-on
3. Make sure that the status of the add-on is **Active** after the installation is finished

3. Addon settings

Go to the addon's page in the admin panel and select the "Settings" tab

Here you can set the delay before the search is triggered, as well as the minimum number of characters in the search string at which the search will work.

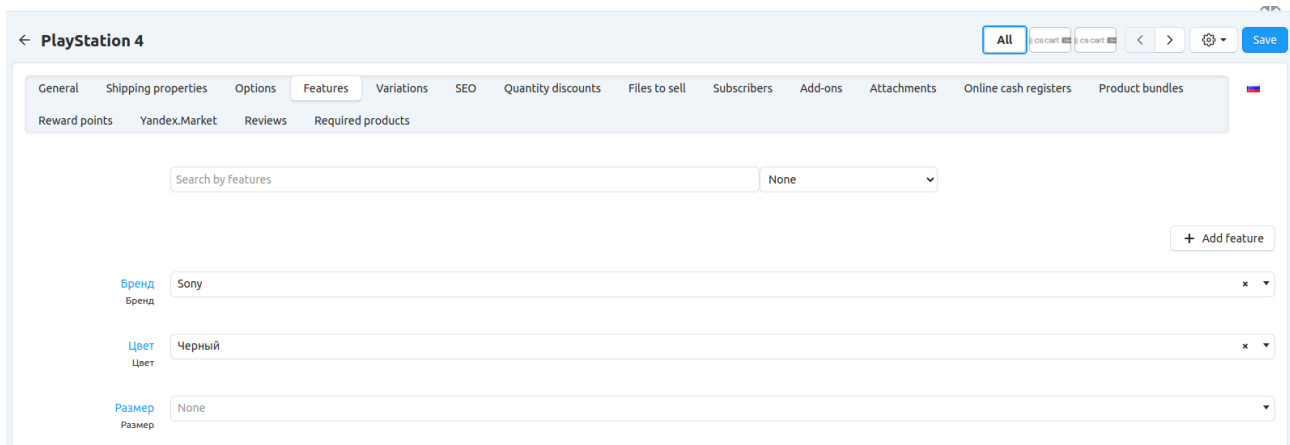

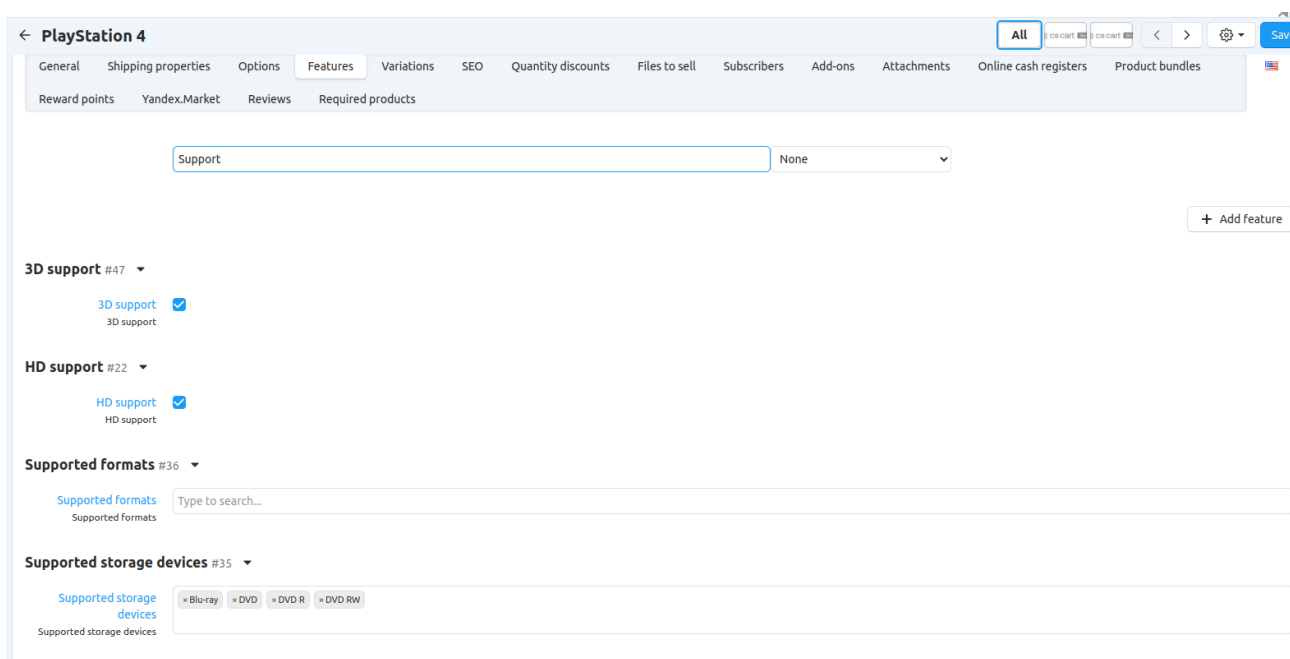
4. Usage example

To see the addon in action, go to the product page in the admin panel and switch to the “Features” tab. Above the list of features, the addon has added a search bar and a toggle for selecting the state of features of the product.



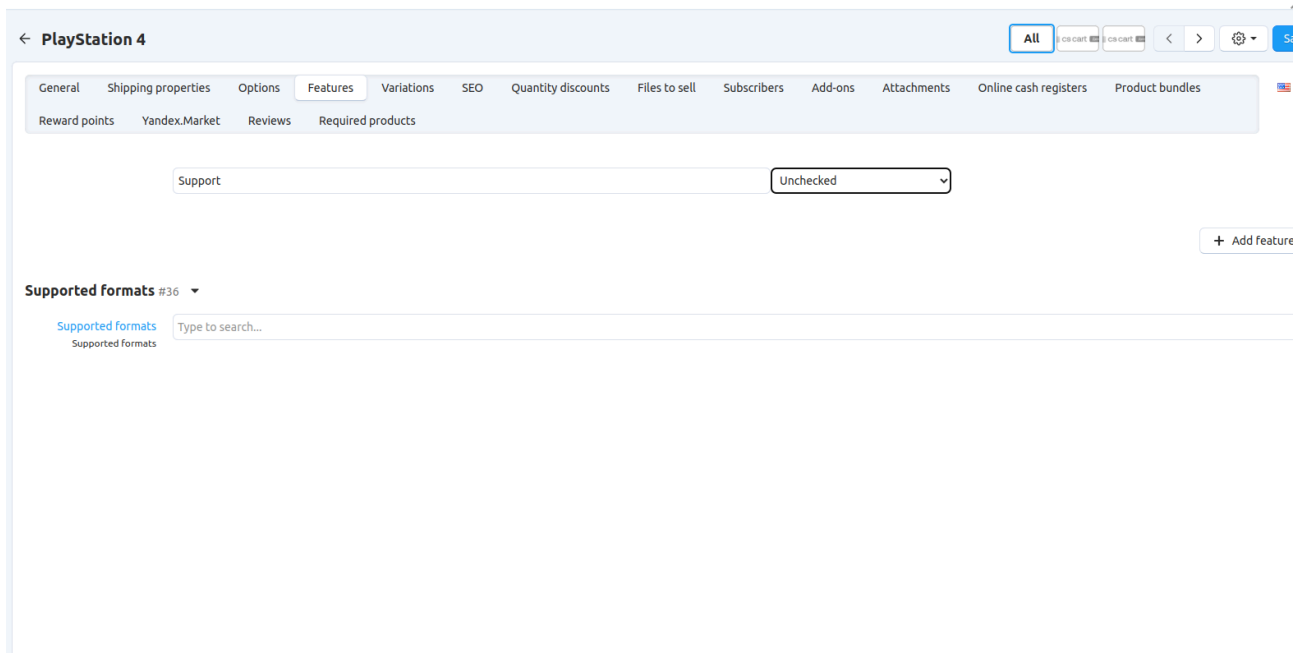
For example, you need to find features that contain the word "support" in the name. We enter “Support” in the search bar and the addon itself will find all the features where the word “Support” is in the name “Support” after you stop typing characters.

The image below shows that the addon has found several features where the word “Support” in the name. As you can see, some features have a set value for this product, and some do not.

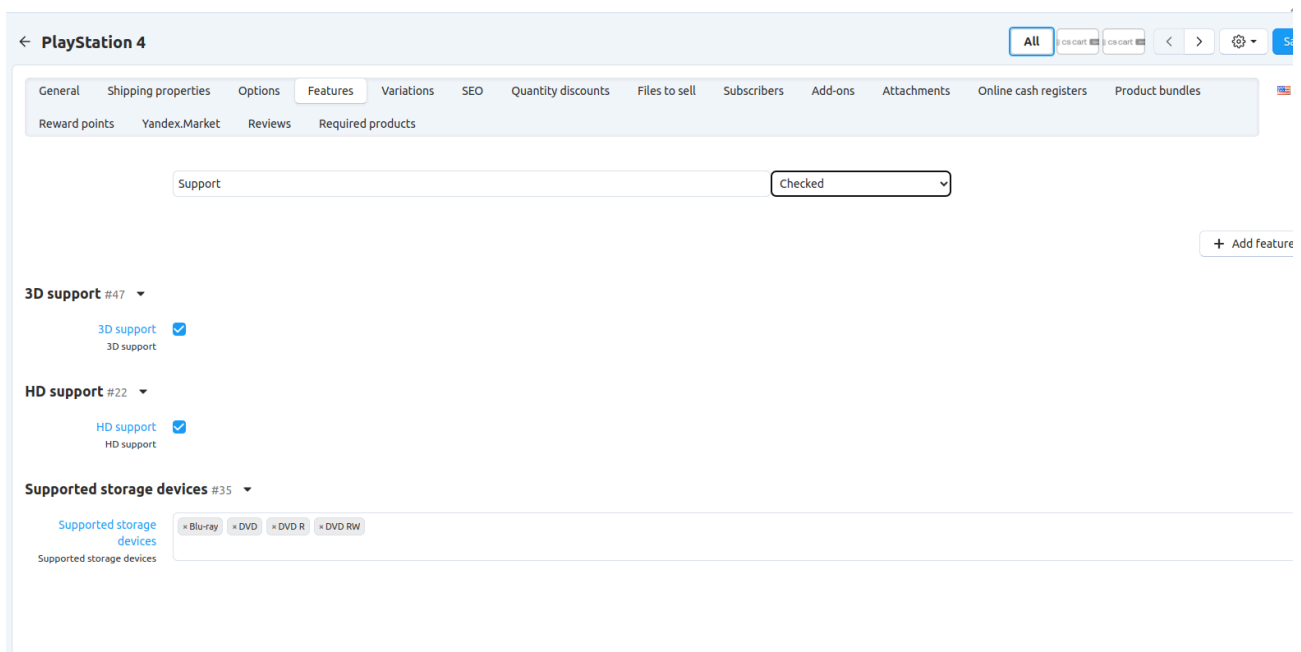


Now let's use the status switch and set it to "Unchecked".

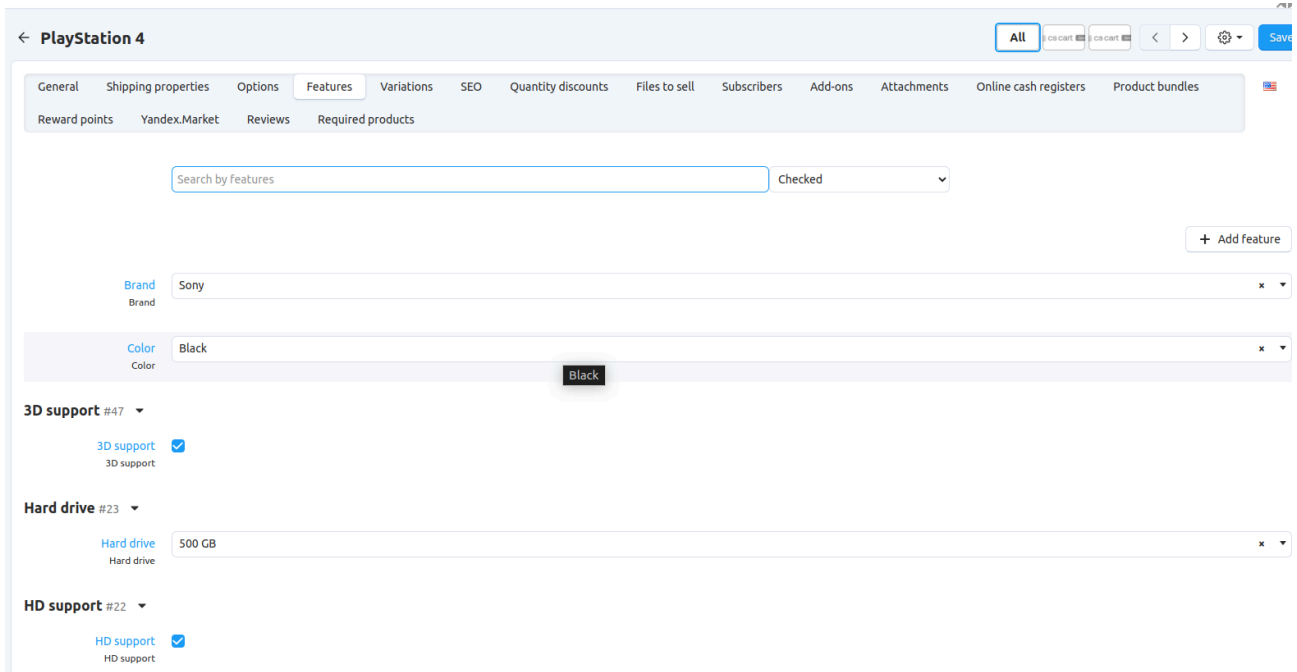
In this case, the addon showed only one feature, the value of which is not set for the product.



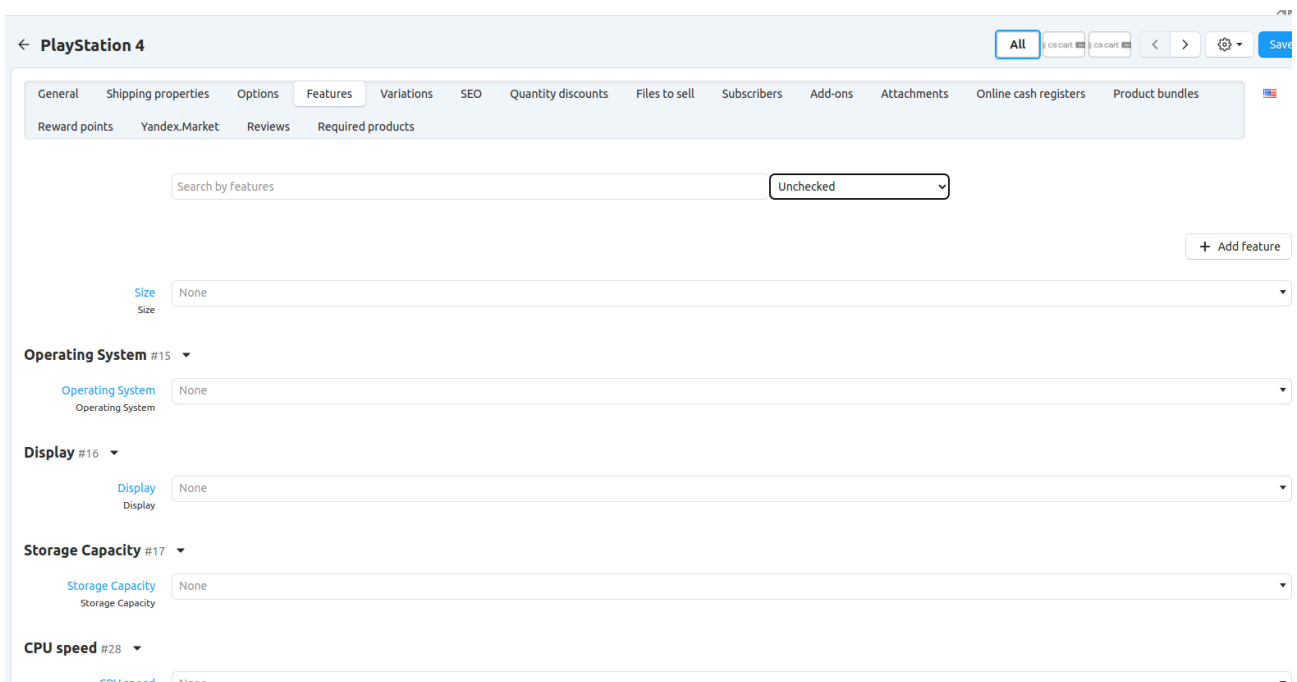
Now set it to the "Checked" state. The addon found all the features with the word "Support" and all have the product value set, the features from the previous image no longer match our request.



The status switch is applicable to all types of features, both to the list of options and to the checkboxes. For example, the search bar will be empty, but the status switch will be set to “Checked”. In this case, the addon will find all the features of the product for which the value is set.



Accordingly, if you switch to “Unchecked”, only those features that do not have a set value in this product will be displayed.



If the switch is set to “None”, both marked and unmarked features will be found.

There is a similar functionality on the characteristics editing page to search for options by name.
