**Welcome**

**Check in will be at the gate entrance near the band room**

- Per CMEA CS guidelines, please provide a student roster to be used in the event of an emergency. The list should include school name, ensemble name(s), Director name, Director cell number, chaperone names, chaperone cell numbers, and a complete list of students attending the festival with you that day.
- Conductor scores are not required
- You must turn in 5 copies of your list of selections and soloists (provided fill in PDF)
- You must turn in a set up sheet at this time.
- You will be assigned a festival host that will guide you and your students around campus and help keep you on time.
- We will have a 25 minute portal to portal time. You will have roughly 25 minutes to warm up, 25 minutes to perform, 25 minutes for a feedback clinic.

We will announce your group and you will announce your selections/soloists as you see fit

Warm up will be in our band room. Case storage will be right outside. We have a very nice stage that has ample space for your jazz ensemble. Following your performance, you will receive a feedback clinic from one of our adjudicators inside our Media Center.

Ratings/Certificates/Soloist Recognitions will be available at our headquarters a short time after your feedback clinic. We will also be recognizing two outstanding musicians of the festival with \$200 scholarships to La Sierra Music Camp. Your judges comments will be uploaded to a shared Google Drive for you to download shortly after your performance. We will also include a video recording of your performance.

### **Security**

Adult chaperones/parents are welcome to attend the festival but must enter on the west side of the cafeteria. There is no admission fee. Students must be supervised at all times. Chaperones must sit with students. The outside restrooms will be available for jazz festival students. There is to be no vaping or use of any alcohol or tobacco on campus. This will be enforced so vandalism and disrespect to other groups and the school do not occur.

### **Provided Equipment**

There will be full rhythm section equipment provided in each room. You may bring your own cymbals if you wish. (Always label your equipment) You will have the choice of an upright acoustic piano or electronic keyboard on stage. Congas and vibes will be provided on stage as well. Bands will perform on risers. There will be microphones available for soloists. If you have any special equipment needs, please contact us.

### **Recordings**

Along with your judges comments, you will receive audio and video recordings of your performance.

### **Food**

We will not have a snack bar. There are fast food restaurants nearby.
