Q: How do I start the course?

A: Click on Modules. Complete the first couple of things inside Canvas. Then click on the links to learn more. (See yellow markings below)

When you click on the link "Working Papers 1-1 (4 pts) ★ FIRST ASSIGNMENT ★ " it will load to a software program called MindTap by Cengage. All of your graded work will sync from MindTap right back to Canvas. Anything that has a paper/pencil icon on the left is a graded assignment. (See blue markings above)

Q: When will my scores from MindTap sync to Canvas?

A: Usually within about 3-5 minutes. You may have to refresh your browser page. It syncs to your dashboard usually within 3-5 hours.

Q: If I want to earn a better score on an assignment or quiz, can I retake it?

A: Yes, you can email Mrs. Sjogren (lsjogren@utahonline.org) and ask to reset a reasonable number of assignments. Please don't wait to send a full list after you are done with the course. And please don't say "Just reset anything that is less than 70%." Please send a specific list of ones you want reset. Just know that the only way to reset a score is to delete it. This means you want to review what you missed before asking me, so you learned from your mistakes the first time. Your original score will stay in Canvas until you redo it. If it is a higher score, it should update in Canvas as usual.

Q: What should I do if I am stuck?

A: Have you looked at the helpful, videos, the powerpoints, or the book? Look there first. If you can't find the answer, contact Mrs. Sjogren.

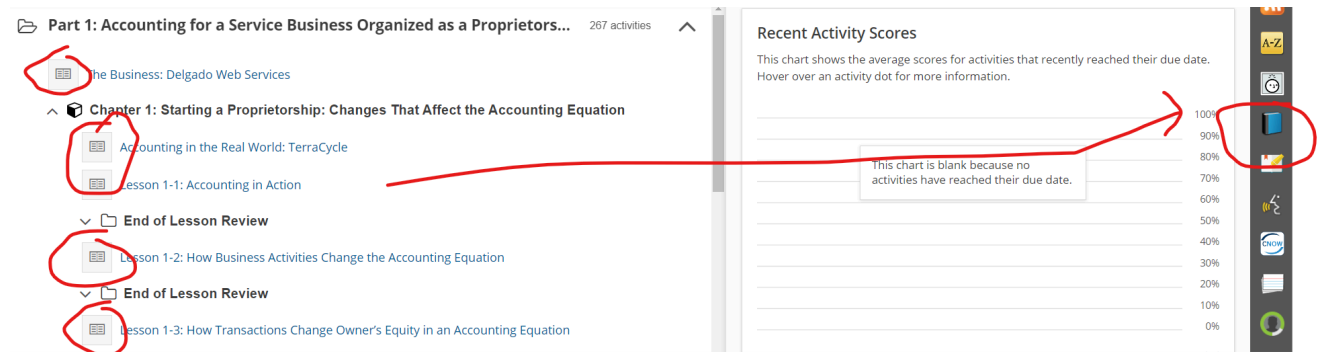
