HISTORY OF MCS

For those members new to MCS – we are a welcoming and competitive club located in a beautiful, rural setting beneath the Malvern Hills. The club was formed in 1980 as a result of the drive and enthusiasm of a few local tennis players, some of whom still play at the club today.

- Free parking in our private off-road car park

OPPORTUNITIES TO PLAY TENNIS

Most important of all, we provide lots of ways to play tennis! Here are all your options for hitting some balls:

- FREE PLAY As an MCS member, there are no limits to how many court bookings you
 can make. So just book a court on our website (see below) and play whenever you
 would like when you book you'll receive a confirmation email with the court and
 clubhouse codes. We also have a club WhatsApp group which can be used to fix up
 games as well.
- CLUB SESSIONS 2 club sessions a week throughout the year on Wednesday evenings (6:00 pm onwards) and Sunday mornings (9:30 am to 1:00 pm). Social doubles tennis is played in a relaxed atmosphere. Just turn up and play! Individual arrangements are made outside those times.
- MCS TEAM IN H&W LEAGUE If it's team tennis you're after, MCS play in the Herefordshire and Worcestershire Mixed, Men's and Ladies leagues in the Summer and Winter Seasons. Details of the captains are on the club noticeboard or speak to anyone at the club who will be able to point you in the right direction.
- COACHING We're very lucky to have Sarah (an experienced Level 3 coach) who offers private and group coaching sessions on a Thursday afternoon/evening and George (a young Level 2 coach) who offers Rusty Rackets & Cardio sessions on a

- CLUB TOURNAMENT There are lots of opportunities to get your hands on some club silverware. We hold 4 fun American tournaments a year on Sunday mornings - a format designed to be enjoyable and accessible to all ages and standards. HOW TO BOOK A COURT

- You can book tennis courts using the LTA ClubSpark system. To access the court booking system members go to "BOOK" section of our website: https://clubspark.lta.org.uk/MCSTennis/Booking
- You will need to use your LTA login to access the booking system and then just select the day, court and time you want to book.
- After booking, you will receive a confirmation email and reminder including the codes for court access, clubhouse access and the defibrillator.
- Please cancel your booking if your plans change.

VISITORS

Members are welcome to bring guests, but must adhere to the following rules which are a condition of membership:

- The day membership fee is £3 per guest.
- Guess visits are limited to 4, after this to continue to play it is necessary to join as a member of MCS.
- You must accompany your guests and you are responsible for their behaviour as well as the payment of their guest fees.

USING FLOODLIGHTS

Tokens for the lights for winter tennis are kept in the cupboard on the right of the passage down to the toilet in the clubhouse. The cost is £4 per court per hour. Simply pay the club directly or leave the money in the token box.

BALLS, MCS KIT & DISCOUNTS

Balls can also be purchased for individual use and to look the part, club kit is also available. Details of who to contact for the balls and kit and all the other MCS products and offers that are available are on the 'DISCOUNTS' section of the club website.
