Choose one character from your book. What one word best describes them (claim)? Explain your claim with specific examples (evidence) and tell how those examples make your character fit that description (reasoning).

How are you liking your book so far? What works, what doesn't? What are you hoping to see in it once you've read further? Give specifics to illustrate your points.
