

Looking For Copies Of A Will After Someone Dies

Someone close to you has died and you believe they made a will, but you can't find one in their house. Check the registrar's records for any correspondence regarding their will if you can't locate a certificate of deposit. If they had requested that the will be kept by the Family Division's Principal Registry, a certificate of deposit should have been delivered to them.

Even if you can't find a certificate of deposit, the Registry may still have a copy of the will. You could ask if a will is available if the person died in a nursing home. If the person passed away in a nursing home, you could enquire about a will.

Contact the person's lawyer, accountant, or bank to find out whether they have the will.

Certainty (<https://certainty.co.uk>) keeps a database of nearly 1 million individuals, and their will may have been recorded by the individual who has died or their legal representative. You can pay for a search of the company's register of wills after the individual's death.

You may also request that the firm contact solicitors in the area where the individual lived to enquire if they have a will.

If you can't uncover a will, you'll have to treat the deceased person's estate as if they had died without one.

Wills and probate solicitors are specifically trained to manage the intricacies of wills and probate. They can help you to understand the process, make sure that everything is done correctly, and represent you in court if necessary.
