Advantages for co-operatives in using an open data approach:

- 1. Ability to connect with customers and test and develop business models and products and services; potentially improves business, reduces costs, increases returns
- 2. Open data approach delivers wider social impact part of a co-operative's mission
- 3. Allows a channel for increased engagement with members (in feedback loops), ultimately increases member oversight of the business

Challenges for co-operatives in using an open data approach:

- Might an open data approach leave a business plan open to being stolen by other companies? (But unique member engagement, co-operative approach cannot be stolen.)
- 2. Finding funding to pay for the development and ongoing costs of an open data approach
- 3. Understanding how willing members are to share data publicly

Could a portal be created for business data from co-operatives?

- A local data co-operative?
