Advantages for co-operatives in using an open data approach:

1. Ability to connect with customers and test and develop business models and products and services; potentially improves business, reduces costs, increases returns
2. Open data approach delivers wider social impact - part of a co-operative's mission
3. Allows a channel for increased engagement with members (in feedback loops), ultimately increases member oversight of the business

Challenges for co-operatives in using an open data approach:

1. Might an open data approach leave a business plan open to being stolen by other companies? (But unique member engagement, co-operative approach cannot be stolen.)
2. Finding funding to pay for the development and ongoing costs of an open data approach
3. Understanding how willing members are to share data publicly
