

Graduation Requirements

To graduate from Horizon School with a diploma a student must earn a minimum of 220 credits in specific course work areas as required by State Law and the DSUSD board of Education.

Graduation Requirements:

English: 4 years (40 credits)

■ 9th grade - English 1

■ 10th grade - English 2

■ 11th grade - English 3

■ 12th grade - English 4

Math: 3 years including Math I (30 credits)

Social Studies: 3 years (30 credits)

■ 10th grade - World History (one year)

Science: 2 years (20 credits)

one year of physical science

Fine Art or Foreign Language: 1 year (10 credits)

one year visual or performing art <u>OR</u>

one year of a foreign language

Physical Education: 2 years (20 credits)

C - Math (Algebra 1/Math I, Geometry/Math II, Algebra II) 3 Years

D - Lab Science (Biology, Chem) 2 Years

E - Foreign Language 2 Years

F - Visual/Performing Arts 1 Year

G - College Prep Elective 1 Year
