Freeding on Smartphones or Tablets

After downloading the Freeding App from the [Apple](#) or [Android](#) app stores, you will be prompted to Search by Library Name or zip code to find Jefferson-Madison Regional Library. Sign in with your existing Freeding account, or create a new one with an email and address.




Once signed in, search for a title to check out or click on My Downloads to redownload books that are still checked out to you. The item will show as Downloading and then open within the Freeding App for you to read.

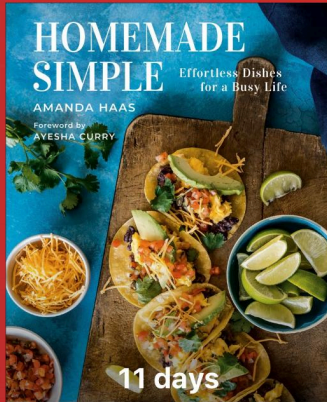

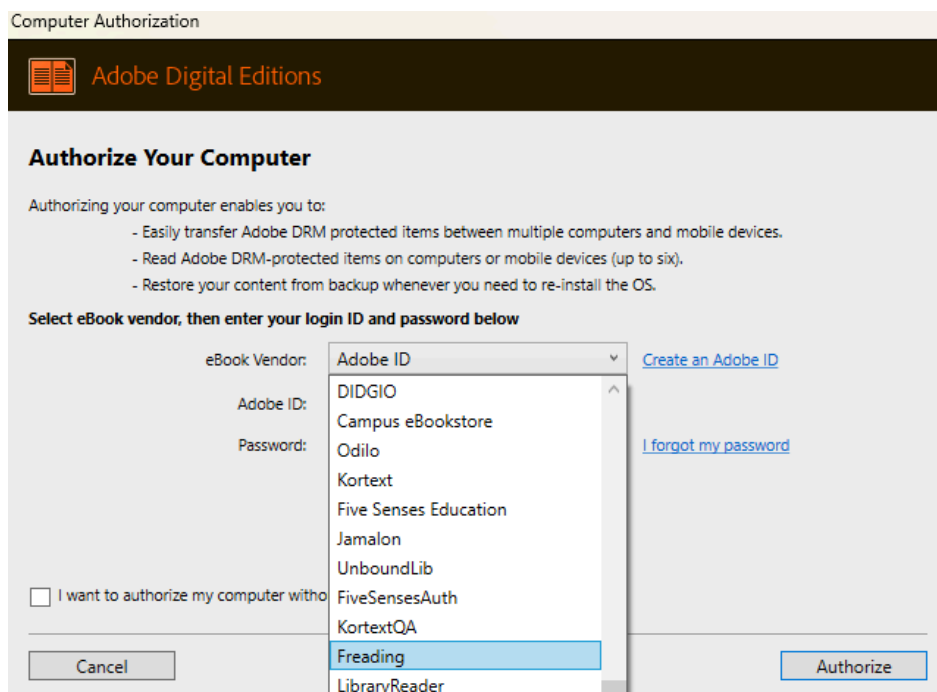

Freeding on a Desktop Computer (Mac or Windows)

In order to download Freeding eBooks, it is necessary to have Adobe Digital Editions installed into your computer. [Adobe Digital Editions](#) is a free software that enables you to read the Freeding eBook downloads, and it also stores and organizes the downloads, at least on a computer.

You no longer need to have an Adobe Account. Once the Adobe Digital Editions is downloaded to your computer, you will authorize the application using Freeding as the eBook Vendor. Select Freeding from the drop down menu:



Your Adobe ID and password is the email address and password you used to Sign Up on the Freeding Website. Select Authorize after entering your login information.
