


Creating a Freading Account

Visit https://jmrl.freading.com/users/signinup to create an account. JMRL card number required to create an account. Your login information will be your email address and a password that you created.


Freading on Smartphones or Tablets


After downloading the Freading App from the <u>Apple</u> or <u>Android</u> app stores, you will be prompted to Search by Library Name or zip code to find Jefferson-Madison Regional Library. Sign in with your existing Freading account, or create a new one with an email and address.





Once signed in, search for a title to check out or click on My Downloads to redownload books that are still checked out to you. The item will show as Downloading and then open within the Freading App for you to read.







The bottom left of the app has a menu where you can switch back and forth between your Library (things you have downloaded) and Get Books (where you can browse the collection and check out more ebooks)








Freading on a Desktop Computer (Mac or Windows)

In order to download Freading eBooks, it is necessary to have Adobe Digital Editions installed into your computer. <u>Adobe Digital Editions</u> is a free software that enables you to read the Freading eBook downloads, and it also stores and organizes the downloads, at least on a computer.

You no longer need to have an Adobe Account. Once the Adobe Digital Editions is downloaded to your computer, you will authorize the application using Freading as the eBook Vendor. Select Freading from the drop down menu:



Your Adobe ID and password is the email address and password you used to Sign Up on the Freading Website. Select Authorize after entering your login information.
