Student e-Bike Registration Procedure for 2026-2027 school year

Purpose

As we have previously shared last year, we are working to continue our support of the safety of our students, staff and families by providing guidance for the use of electric bikes (e-bikes) at Reedy High School.

As a part of our process, we are requiring any student that is riding an electric bikes (e-bikes) to school to register their e-bike and/or electric bikes with campus administration for the 2026-2027 school year.

Distinction of Electric Scooters compared to E-Bikes

As shared by the city of Frisco and Frisco ISD, electric scooters are now prohibited from all public right of ways and public property including FISD campuses and will not be allowed at any time.

E-Bike Procedure Overview

- All student-owned e-bikes brought onto campus must be registered with Reedy High School for 2026-2027 school year.
- There is no cost for the registration of e-bikes (bikes that pedal with electric motor assistance) with the school
- Upon registration, students will receive a permit sticker for 2026-2027 school year that must be visibly affixed in the designated location provided by the campus to their e-bike.
- The permit sticker helps school staff identify authorized vehicles and helps to support our ongoing efforts for school safety.

- *Electric bikes without pedals (bike is only electric and does not require pedaling at all) will have to obtain a parking permit. These bikes are considered motor vehicles and require a driver's license, registration and proof of insurance to receive a parking permit.*

Registration Process

1. Students must complete an e-Bike form, available in the AP Office or found [HERE](#) (Students must use their FISD student account to access form) for 2026-2027 school year.
2. Upon submission of the form, students will be issued a numbered permit sticker that they can collect from the AP office the following school day.
3. Stickers must be placed in the designated location, provided by the campus, on the frame of the e-bike.

Important Distinction - Electric Bikes without pedals

Students riding electric motorized bikes that have foot pegs and no functional pedals:

- Must apply for a [parking permit](#) as these vehicles will require registration, proof of insurance and a drivers license for the application.
- These vehicles (electric bikes) are subject to the same expectations as all other motorized vehicles operating on campus.
- Parking permits must be placed in a visible location on the frame of the electric motorized bike.

These types of vehicles are not considered e-bikes and are subject to different requirements to be operated on campus.

Rules & Expectations

- Only students with valid Reedy High School-issued permits for 2026-2027 school year attached to their bike may park and operate their e-bikes or motorized bikes on campus.
- Vehicles must be parked in designated parking areas (bike racks for e-bikes and/or elec. and a student designated parking spot for electric motorized bikes without pedals)
- Riding e-bikes on sidewalks, walkways, and on school grounds is **prohibited**.
- Students must walk their e-Bikes upon arrival at school and until departure from school
- Students must obey all applicable traffic and safety laws when commuting to and from school.

Enforcement

- Students attempting to ride e-bikes on campus grounds may be subject to:
 - Parent notification
 - Loss of riding privileges
 - Disciplinary consequences including after-school detention
- Unregistered or improperly parked vehicles may be subject to:
 - Parent notification.
 - Temporary confiscation.
 - Loss of riding and/or parking privileges.
- Repeated violations may result in additional disciplinary action.

Implementation Date

Our campus process for e-bikes will go into effect on Tuesday August 18, 2026.

Students can begin to register their electronic bikes (e-bikes) with Reedy High School with the link provided above starting August 2nd.
