Role Description

In addition to the legal responsibilities we are looking for directors to help determine the organisation's strategic direction through the scrutiny of plans and reports from the executive team. We want to benefit from your experience in CSR and in growing and stabilising organisations. This could include making introductions that might help the programme progress.

The Directors have the [full legal responsibility required of them by UK law](#). As a CIC there are a [few additional responsibilities](#) relating to reporting and asset locks. It will be your collective duty to ensure that the company is being responsibly run. You will be provided with the information you require for Board meetings by the Executive Director and you will have the right to call for any further information that you require.

There will be two official board meetings per year. One virtual for a couple of hours, and a second half day meeting at the company offices in Bath. Additional short virtual ad hoc meetings may be called at the discretion of directors.

Between meetings we will use Basecamp to brief the Board, ask for advice and share information in a timely manner, for example quarterly cash-flow reports. Decisions taken over Basecamp will be minuted and accepted as Board decisions.

Term of service:

Directors will be appointed for three years with one year extensions as agreed by the board.
