Winter Bowling

Short Mat Bowling (2mats)

Sessions are held in our clubhouse on Monday, Wednesday and Friday afternoons, from October to March, all full members are welcome. Registration 15 min. before start time. After these sessions arrangements should be made by the bowlers to have the mats rolled away if required.
