# **RULES FOR THE WOMEN'S TOURNAMENT**

# **GENERAL RULES:**

- 1. Tournament will be played on Tennis Ball.
- 2. The total number of teams participating would be 4.
- 3. The Captain of Team should be a Chartered Accountant ('CA')
- 4. All the matches will be played at Shinde High School Cricket Ground, Near Taljai, Pune 411009.

# **PARTICIPATION FEES:**

- CA Member Participation Fees for CA Member is Rs. 1,000 including GST
- CA Article and Student Participation Fees for CA Article and Students is Rs. 500 including GST

#### **ELIGIBILITY FOR PARTICIPATION:**

- i) ICAI MEMBERS i.e. A Chartered Accountant having valid membership number and has paid the membership fees till FY 2023-24 and is a member of Pune Branch or Pimpri Chinchwad Branch of WIRC of ICAI as on date of document submission.
- ii) **ICAI STUDENT ARTICLES i.e.** Students of ICAI having valid student registration number

## **PLAYING KIT:**

- 1. Only T-shirt will be provided by Pune Branch of WIRC of ICAI as per details submitted by the team. It is mandatory to play with t- shirt given by Pune branch. Wearing black colour track pant is mandatory for all matches.
- 2. The team itself should arrange for the playing kits, except for the cricket balls. Batting gloves while batting and wicket keeping gloves while keeping the wickets can be used.

## **DETAILS OF TOURNAMENT:**

1. Each team to play minimum 3 league matches on a road to qualify for the Finals.

- 2. All matches will be played for 6 overs including Final.
- 3. Each Bowler can bowl maximum 2 overs in a match, and minimum 5 bowlers should be used.
- 4. In every league match all team should start with new opening pairs of batter (both batter needs to be new). Failure to do so may disqualify team from knock-out stage.
- 5. Each player of squad shall be part of playing 11 at least in 1 match. Failure to do so may disqualify team from knock-out stage.
- 6. Overs may be reduced due to unforeseen circumstances like weather, dew, bad light etc. Maximum overs per bowler shall be reduced proportionately in case overs are reduced.
- 7. The reporting time for the team is One hour before the scheduled time of the match. The toss will be held 30 minutes before the scheduled time of the match. If team fails to report on scheduled time, the team present may get walk over as per the decision of the officials.
- 8. Each innings shall be completed within 20 minutes all matches.
- 9. There will not be any drinks break during the innings. Also, team shall ensure that only 12th player can enter the ground during match for purpose of providing water, bats, etc. and only with prior permission of Umpires. In case of delay caused by any team, the umpires shall take appropriate action.
- 10. Every match will have a prize for the PLAYER OF THE MATCH. There will also be overall prizes for the PLAYER OF THE TOURNAMENT, BEST KEEPER, BEST BOWLER, & BEST BATTER.
- 11. Format of the league would be round robin (one match with each other team) with top two teams (points and NRR) would qualify for the final game.
- 12. Winning teams will be awarded 2 points; losing teams will not be awarded any

- points. In case match is not completed for whatever reason, each team would be awarded 1 point each.
- 13. In case of tie, super over would decide the winner, where only 1 bowler will be permitted to bowl & 3 Batsmen can bat i.e. 2 wickets will be considered as All Out. For super over, all the rules of the tournament will be applicable mutatis mutandis. In case of tie another super over will be played till the result is arrived.
- 14. At the most, five fielders can be on the leg side, at any given point of time.
- 15. Runner for batter will not be allowed under any circumstances.
- 16. Only one bouncer per over will be allowed. (Above shoulder below head).
- 17.Leg before wicket (LBW) has been ruled out as a dismissal in the tournament. Hence, the batter cannot be out by the way of Leg before wicket (LBW).
- 18. Rules as implemented in T20 cricket shall be applicable to the matches, except for the points specifically mentioned in the rules of CACL 2024.

#### **IMPORTANT CLARIFICATIONS:**

- 1. Cricket is a game that owes much of its unique appeal to the fact that it should be played not only with its Laws but also within the Spirit of the Game. Any action which is seen to abuse this sprit causes injury to the game itself. The major responsibility for ensuring the spirit of fair play rest with the captains of both the teams. Teams are responsible for the behavior of the players, members and any person traveling with the team during the matches as well as the functions organized pre- and post-tournament.
- 2. All decisions of the Sports Committee of the PUNE Branch of WIRC of ICAI shall be final & binding on all the participating teams.
- 3. The Sports Committee of PUNE Branch of WIRC of ICAI reserves the right to amend the rules before the start of the tournament after conveying to all teams.
- 4. Decisions TAKEN or GIVEN by the Official will be final & binding to all the participating TEAMS.
