As the standard of living is getting higher, more and more people are buying cars just as they are buying T.V. sets. It is, however, debatable if buying a car in an urban area is advantageous or not. **Having a car in an urban area, on the one hand, provides the owner with comfort and safety but on the other hand involves a lot of worry and expenses/ hoặc (In the following essay, the pros and cons of using car in big city be analyzed in more detail.)- thesis statement**

There are some advantages to owning a car in an urban area. **First**, sitting in your car is much more **comfortable** than having to wait a long time for the arrival of the bus or train. On the other hand, there are some **negative points** of such a measure. **First**, this would be a heavy **burden** on car drivers. At present, taxes on private cars are already high for a lot of people, and so further taxes would only mean less money at the end of the month for most people who may have no choice but to drive every day. **Another problem is that** this type of tax would likely be set at a **fixed amount** for all who use car as a means of transport. **This would mean that** it would hit those with less money harder, while the rich could afford it. 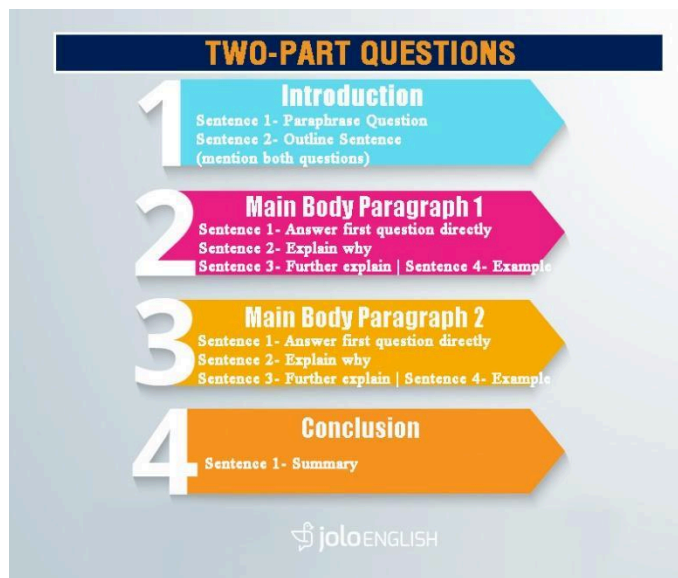

The Sunday Times recently reported that 72% of college graduates in the UK admitted to copying and pasting Wikipedia articles at least once.

Overall, **it is a very positive development** because most students will take advantage of the power of the information superhighway to enhance their studies, rather than using it to cheat. For example, in 2005 Cambridge University found that students who regularly used a computer were 26% more likely to get a first-class degree than those who did not.

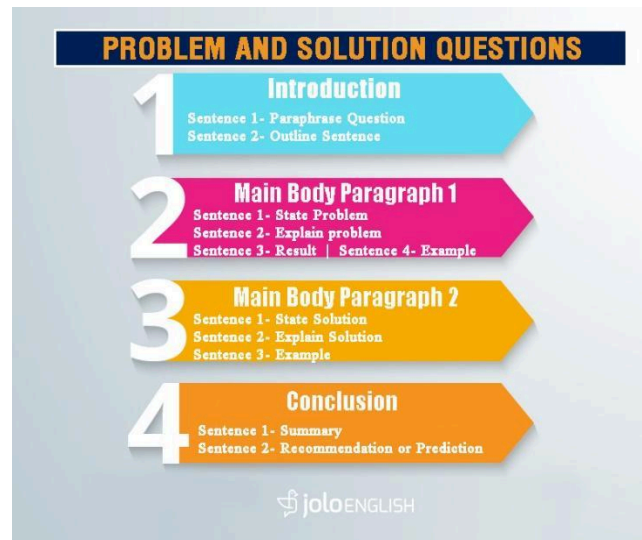
