IT support for all public libraries including:

- Office 365 - provided for all staff members of public libraries

- E-rate – one on one assistance with filing forms

- Help desk – to report any issue that requires assistance

- Remote assistance – the ability for MLC to log in and troubleshoot computers remotely

- Procurement support – to ensure compliance with all federal and state laws

- Needs assessments – determine library needs based on community input

- Project management – assist with IT projects with third party vendors or internal staff

- Website design and hosting – design and host public library websites

Dedicated consultant for each library to provide advice, guidance, and support for library matters.

Continuing education programming for all library staff across the state.

Talking Book Services to provide accessible materials to those with low vision. (E-reader machines, BARD, braille materials, audio magazines, large print loans and more)

OCLC for cataloging and metadata

Autism Support – providing support groups in libraries for parents with autistic children and training for library professionals on engaging with patrons with disabilities

LibGuides – digital resources for librarians on various topics

Public Relations Support – assistance with content creation, social media platforms, library support materials

Digital Archives – MLC is the depository for state documents

Veterans History Project – Recording live stories from veterans for historical documentation

Patent and Trademark Resource Center– Assist researchers with tools and resources for searches

Subgrants to libraries:
