**MALAG Guidelines for Doing Research: Synopsis in English**

1. An Action Research study on own teaching is a suitable framework for conducting research in the M.Ed. program.
2. A research project with students in a class that is not yours is also suitable. This needs permission from parents, the School Principal and the teacher.
3. Be cautious about what information is given in publications.
4. Make sure there is no information that can be used to identify participants in the written study.
5. Attain permission from parents and school principal for conducting research in your own classes.
6. To interview teachers who are colleagues and not under your leadership, you only need their permission.
7. If you wish to interview teachers under your leadership you need the permission of the Chief Scientist (of the Ministry of Education).
8. Action research involves testing and evaluating yourself and /or your own actions, not someone else's actions.
9. If you want to do a more extensive research study in another institution you need the permission of the Chief Scientist (of the Ministry of Education).
10. If you want to do a study that is not about your own practice, you can do it in another class and do not need the permission of the Chief Scientist.
11. Do not submit transcripts or other recorded material; to anyone else.
12. If you are conducting research in a class that you teach, grades should not be given for any pupils' work used for research purposes.
