 - a. Beanstack

- i. Nothing new to share... essentially we waiting for the procurement to come through sole source authority does not go out for bid has to go through many more hoops requires governor's signature
- ii. DPI is continuing to meet with Beanstack our expectation is that libraries that want to use Beanstack beyond April 2023 will be able to do so
 - 1. Chris and Monica will ask for clarification from Beanstack on what happens to user accounts and "built" library programs if there ends up being an unexpected "gap" in service.
- b. Workshop planning TENTATIVE!
 - i. In the past, DPI has offered a "Youth Services Institute"; 3 day intensive conference/retreat.
 - ii. Right now, things are very much in the exploratory phase of what a future Youth Services workshop would look like; a "hybrid" workshop bringing together Public Youth Services Librarians & School Librarians.
 - iii. Bringing in CCBC as a connecting point; social time, strategizing about partnerships and troubleshooting issues together.
