## **Info & Terms**

**SC** = Single Cask. If you see this abbreviation next to one of our whiskies, it means that the liquid has come from one cask. No two casks are identical, making each single cask unique.

**CS** = Cask Strength. Most run-of-the-mill whiskies are diluted down by the distiller before they are bottled. Cask strength whiskies are taken straight from the cask at full strength and put directly into the bottle. Don't be afraid to add a bit of water to whisky – it can often improve the nose and the palate. It's best to try a whisky neat, and if you think it's a bit too hot, add a couple of drops, give the glass a swirl to integrate the water, and try it again, repeat this process until you find a strength that works. We recommend this method as whisky needs strength - too much water can kill a whisky, and if you put too much in at the start you can't take it back out.

**Non-chill filtered/Un-Chill filtered whisky** = Chill filtering is a process that is used by many distillers which removes compounds such as esters, and fatty acids. Most of the whiskies on this menu will not have undergone chill filtration, meaning you get a less processed and more flavourful whisky with more texture.

**Silent Distillery** = There are a number of distilleries that are no longer in existence; these distilleries closed their doors for a multitude of reasons, from financial hardship to irreparable damage caused by fires. These whiskies become rarer each day as they continue to be consumed, whilst no more is produced.

**Single Malt** = A whisky made from 100% malted barley, distilled in copper pot stills, originating from one 'single' distillery.

**Single Grain** = A whisky that can be made from a number of different grains (maize, barley, corn, etc) originating from one 'single' distillery. These whiskies are generally produced using a column still. Single grain whiskies usually require a longer period in the cask before reaching a high standard.

**Blended Whisky** = The most consumed type of whisky in the world. These are a mixture of whiskies from malt distilleries and grain distilleries.

**Blended Malt** = A vatting of whiskies from a number of different malt distilleries.

We try to keep whisky accessible for all budgets, so for this reason 60-70% of the backbar is priced at £6-8 a dram. **Remember, you can use the search function to find your favourites!**
