OVERVIEW

A Student Praise Team Member is anyone who is participating within the WSM Praise Team. Student Praise Team Members will have a wide variety of ways they can serve on the WSM Praise Team, such as providing vocal leadership for songs, playing a musical instrument, assisting the WSM Praise Director with prepping the stage area and instruments before praise rehearsals and Youth Group, along with other things at the discretion of the WSM Praise Director. Each SPTM is expected to take corporate praise and worship seriously as it is for enjoying and praising God.

Pre-Requisites: Desire to pursue Jesus, one semester of faithful WSM involvement, and 1 character reference.

TIME COMMITMENT: *2-3 hours a week - Spread over 1 or 2 days.*

DESCRIPTION

Under the oversight of the WSM Praise Director and Student Ministry Pastor, a SPTM will be responsible for the following:

- Attending any WSM Praise Team meetings or rehearsals they are assigned to participate in, unless unable to due to personal reasons. Proper notification with the WSM Praise Director if they are unable to attend.
- Practicing and becoming familiar with songs they will be playing for praise and worship.
- Behaving in a Christ honoring way both inside and outside of WSM activities.
- Giving thought, prayer, and action to any assigned discipleship tasks given by the WSM Praise Director.
- Maintaining a deep and connected relationship with other students within WSM and attending, as able, Youth Group, Grow Groups, and other WSM activities.
- Cleaning up their space on stage after events where they are participating on a praise and worship band.
