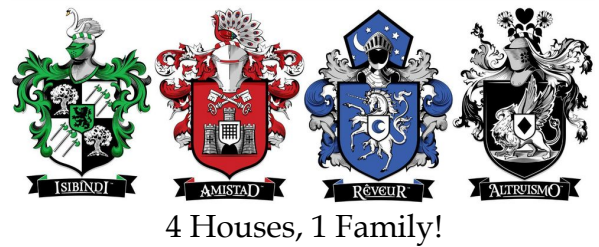

What is the House System?

The House System is a school-wide community program that groups students and staff into one of four Houses, each with its own unique values, colors, and traditions.
