## **How Do Students Get to Camp?**

You can register with or without bus transportation.

With Bus: Buses depart from the Newlife Training Center in Silverdale at 7:30
 AM on July 21. Cost: \$185 round trip.

Without Bus: You are responsible for transporting your student. Creative options include carpooling with families, group leaders, or volunteers.
 If you opt out of the bus, you must complete the <u>Transportation Form.</u>

### Where & When is Bus Drop-Off and Pick-Up?

- **Drop-Off:** Monday, July 21, **6:30 AM** @ Newlife Training Center (check-in and luggage drop)
- Pick-Up: Friday, July 25, 7:00–9:00 PM @ Newlife Training Center (You'll receive text updates during the return trip.)

#### Can Students Choose Roommates or Leaders?

Yes! You can request a roommate or leader during registration. We do our best to honor these requests but cannot guarantee them.

## What If My Student Can't Attend Anymore?

Camp registrations are **non-refundable**, but you can transfer your registration to another student. Email **camps@newlife.tv** with the student's name and contact info.

#### What's the Check-In Process Like?

- Turn in any waivers and medications at check-in.
- Meds go to the camp nurse, either:
  - Monday, July 21 @ the buses
  - Or at Silver Lake check-in if transporting student yourself.
- Required forms:
  - [Medication Administration Form]
  - [Self-Administer Form for Epi-Pen/Inhaler]

#### Is Early Check-In Available?

Yes! Available **Sunday, July 20** at all Newlife locations, based on your selection during registration:

- **South Kitsap** 8:45A, 10:15A, 11:30A @ Sidney Commons

Note: Medicine can only be turned in to the nurse on Monday, July 21.

## **Can I Send Medicine with My Student?**

Yes. If they're capable of self-administering, they may bring it. If not, camp medical staff can assist.

- Controlled substances require:
  - Original pharmacy bottle
  - Only enough meds for the week
  - Signed doctor's note
- Required Forms:
  - [Medication Admin Form]
  - o [Self-Administer Form]

## What Should Students Bring?

Max 2 bags: 1 small personal, 1 luggage + sleeping bag/pillow.

#### **Packing List:**

- Bible, notebook, pen
- Pillow & sleeping bag
- Clothing (theme nights, warm layers, appropriate swimwear)
- Toiletries (deodorant, toothbrush, etc.)
- Towel, sunscreen, bug spray

- Reusable water bottle
- Sack lunch or \$\$ for Monday's drive

## What Should Students NOT Bring?

To help create a distraction-free week, students should NOT bring:

- Video games, laptops
- Skateboards, jewelry

#### Banned Items (will result in dismissal):

- Knives, firearms, fireworks
- Tobacco, vapes, alcohol, drugs

### **How Does the Camp Bank Work?**

Deposit funds online before or during camp.

- Leftover balances under \$10 go to Newlife's camp scholarship fund

#### Is There a Lost & Found?

#### What Behavior is Expected?
