Attention Coaches & AD's

We are thrilled to be able to host the **Norm Manstedt BOYS** Wrestling Tournament at the new Columbus Field House in Columbus Nebraska. We know that this new site will provide an exciting atmosphere for the wrestlers, coaches and fans.

Obviously, there will be some changes to overcome for all involved but nothing that will change the quality of the wrestling on the mats.

• Parking: All team vans and bus parking will be in designated areas, TBD. Parent and fan parking will be in Lots C & D (east & north sides of the Field House)

• Admission:

- 1. Boys Daily Admission Prices: <u>Adults \$10.00 Students \$5.00</u> (each day). Everyone will receive a wrist band to enter the wrestling area
- 2. Spectators will not be allowed in the YMCA area or 2nd floor of the field house without purchasing a Day Pass at the YMCA Office in the lobby
- 3. No Food or Drinks (other than water bottles) Parents that bring coolers will need to leave the coolers in the lobby/commons area where food can be consumed... this will be strictly enforced
- 4. Spectator seating will be located around the **Eight (8) mats** with chairs, benches and small bleachers, parents may bring lawn chairs if they wish.
- 5. There is a coffee shop w/seating, along with a concessions area in the lobby

Coaches & Team Members

- 1. All team members will be stamped when they check in. Coaches will be provided with name badges which will allow entry to the mat area and coaches hospitality area.
- We are allowing a maximum of <u>three (3) complimentary coaches passes</u> and <u>two (2)</u> <u>managers passes</u>, additional pass's may be purchased for \$10.00 and \$5.00 respectfully.

- 3. These passes are good for both Friday & Saturday of the boy's tournament. Your Coaches Badge allows you access to the mat area and coaches hospitality area.
- 4. Only <u>Two (2)</u> coaches are allowed in the red/green coaching area, managers, statisticians and video people will <u>NOT</u> be allowed inside the mat area but may be seated on the Field Turf behind the barrier ropes
- A team area will be provided on the Tennis Court Area along the east end of the Field House, wrestlers may store their coolers in the area only. (NO FOOD ON THE FIELD TURF AREA)
- 6. Large locker rooms/ rest rooms are **ONLY** available for changing and showers, this will be monitored and strictly enforced throughout the meet. Do not leave any personal items in the locker rooms

Additional Notes:

- 1. Doors will open at **7:00 AM**, please do not arrive before 7:00 AM
- 2. Large White Screens, Video Board and smaller TVs will be positioned to show around the Field House showing on deck mat assignments

3. No Food on Field Turf at any time

Norm Manstedt Boys Tournament Format – Jan 10 & 11, 2025

- 1. Entry Deadline: Team Entries are due on Trackwrestling by noon Wednesday Jan 8, 2025
- 2. Entry Fees: \$\frac{\$ 175.00 per team}{}, payable to High Plains Community, Attention Greg Wood
- 3. Wrestlers will weigh in by teams (on Friday) in a designated area on 6 (or more) certified scales. Saturday weigh ins will be (by weight classes)

4. Starting Times (EACH DAY)

- a. Scales will open @ 8:00 AM
- b. Weigh ins will begin @ 8:30 AM
- c. Coaches are responsible for recording their team's weights on their Certified Weigh-in Sheets

- d. 1st Round matches will begin @ 9:30 AM (approximately)
- e. We will wrestle on Eight (8) mats throughout the day

Format:

- Wrestlers will be seeded by <u>Colin Pfeifer & the High Plains Coaching Staff</u> using the NSAA seeding criteria in addition to returning Manstedt Tournament placers
- Deadline for entries is Tuesday Noon, Jan 7, 2025
- Late scratches are permitted, however a wrestler can not be scratched from a weight class and moved to another weight class. You may replace the scratched wrestler with another team member and (may or may not receive a seed)
- Seeds may need to be moved within the pools due to late scratches

Friday:

- We will wrestle each weight class of four (4) pools of six wrestlers each
- Wrestling will continue throughout the day on eight (8) mats
- The 1st & 2nd place wrestlers in each pool on Friday will advance to the **Championship Bracket** on Saturday **(8-man bracket)** on **four (4) mats**
- The <u>3rd & 4th</u> place wresters in each pool on Friday will advance to a <u>Consolation Bracket</u> on Saturday (8-man bracket) on <u>four (4) mats</u>
- Wrestlers may only earn **bonus points** on Friday

Saturday:

- Championship & consolation matches will run continuously on all eight (8) mats until the championship finals which will be wrestled on two (2) mats
- Sixteen (16) place team scoring: beginning on 2nd day of the meet
- Six (6) place medals per weight class (Championship Bracket Only)
- Other Awards: Most Falls Least Time and Two (2) OWA
