School Improvement Goal: Lucy V. Barnsley Elementary School will earn a <u>five-</u>star rating on the Maryland School Report Card in 2025, increasing earned points from 69 to at least 75 points.

Literacy Goal: In SY26, the percentage of K-2 students reaching proficiency on DIBELS will increase from 64% to 69% with a focus on:

- Hispanic/Latino students (50% to 55%)
- Students with disabilities (36% to 41%)
- EML Learners (54% to 59%)

Instructional Focus: Increase active participation and literacy skills through explicit, systematic language-based skills and code-based skills (fluency, phonics, phonological awareness. comprehension) instruction through consistent FIT groups.

Instructional Focus: Increase active participation and develop language and comprehension skills through explicit vocabulary instruction, structured *academic discourse*, and interactions with complex texts (read-alouds, structured reading, responding) in daily FIT groups.
