



Madison Consolidated Schools Migrant Education Program End of Eligibility

Dear Parent or Guardian:

This letter is to inform you that your child no longer qualifies for the Migrant Education Program. Your child has not moved in the last 36 months. Because your child has not moved in the last 36 months, he or she is no longer eligible for this program. If your family makes a migratory move in the future, your child may meet the eligibility requirements and be enrolled in the program again.

The following services may have been provided to your child through the Migrant Education Program:

- Automatic eligibility for free breakfast, lunch, or both
- Instructional services for migratory children, such as tutoring in math or reading
- Support services for migratory children, such as transportation, counseling or other health support services
- Referral services for migratory children to other agencies supporting migrant families

Your child may continue to receive services through our Migrant Education Program for up to one additional year if no comparable services are available from other programs.

In addition, your child may still qualify for the following programs and supports, if available, provided by the local school district:

- Free breakfast, lunch, or both;
- Title I services for disadvantaged students (based on your child's educational needs);
- Supplemental English Learner services from Title I, Title III, or both if available;
- Other:

Your child's eligibility for these services is based on your family's income and your child's educational needs. Please contact your child's school to obtain an application for free or reduced-price lunch. If your child is an English learner, he or she will continue to receive supplemental English learner services until he or she reaches proficiency in English. Proficiency in a language is a measure of a person's ability to understand and communicate in that language or in a person's preferred mode of communication.

Estimado padre/madre/tutor:

El objetivo de esta carta es informarle que su hijo(a) ya no cumple con los requisitos para participar en el Programa educativo para migrantes. Su hijo(a) no se ha mudado durante los últimos 36 meses. Debido a esto, ya no cumple con los requisitos para este programa. Si su familia realiza algún traslado migratorio en el futuro, su hijo(a) puede cumplir con los requisitos de elegibilidad e inscribirse nuevamente en el programa.

Es posible que su hijo(a) haya recibido los siguientes servicios a través del Programa educativo para migrantes:

- Elegibilidad automática para recibir desayuno gratuito, almuerzo gratuito o ambos
- Servicios de instrucción para alumnos migrantes, como tutoría en Matemáticas o lectura
- Servicios de apoyo para alumnos migrantes, como servicios de transporte, asesoramiento u otros servicios de salud
- Servicios de remisión para alumnos migrantes a otros organismos de asistencia a familias migrantes

Su hijo(a) puede continuar recibiendo servicios a través de nuestro Programa educativo para migrantes durante un año adicional como máximo si no se encuentran disponibles servicios similares de otros programas.

Asimismo, su hijo(a) aún puede cumplir con los requisitos para los siguientes programas y apoyos, en caso de estar disponibles, de parte del distrito escolar local:

Desayuno gratuito, almuerzo gratuito o ambos;

- Servicios del Artículo I para alumnos desfavorecidos (según las necesidades educativas de su hijo(a));
- Servicios complementarios para alumnos de inglés del Artículo I, el Artículo III o ambos, en caso de estar disponibles;
