Holy Cross Parish Scholarship Agreement

Holy Cross Parish exists to help parishioners grow in relationship with Jesus so they can then go forth and share His love with others in their daily lives. Recognizing the importance of incorporating our faith into the education of our children, Holy Cross is firmly committed to supporting all families who desire a Catholic education. As a sign of this commitment, the Church subsidizes school expenses. This means all families who pay the "in parish" rate receive tuition assistance.

Families who receive the "in parish" tuition rate have always been expected to be parishioners of Holy Cross, although a Parish Scholarship model is being implemented in order to emphasize the church/school relationship and foster one community in our Parish. This agreement serves to document the expectations for families who receive the discounted tuition rate and outline the general philosophy of Holy Cross that parents are the primary educators of their children and faith formation should be a priority at home as well as at school.

Parish scholarships are available to every family who meets the following requirements:

- Are registered members of Holy Cross parish
- Attend weekend mass regularly at Holy Cross
- Adhere to the school attendance policy
- Serve in at least one parish ministry or event (Celebration, Fall Festival, Cantor, Lector, Altar Server, Eucharistic Minister, Committee, Circle, Catechesis of the Good Shepherd, Adoration Chapel, Music Ministry, Landscaping, Painting, Building Repairs, Cleaning, Maintenance, etc.)
- Practice good stewardship of time, talent, and treasure

To register as a member of the parish, you may call the church office (913-381-2755) and meet with Richard Warwick, the parish manager and fill out the parish registration & stewardship commitment forms. Our pastor, Father Owaldo will review the forms and meet with newly registered families. For those who are currently receiving the Holy Cross Parish Scholarships but have not filled out the parish registration & stewardship commitment forms will be contacted by the parish office.
