I hope this story will inspire you — for the journey of a thousand miles starts with its first step 💜 🔥 .





Doing puzzle rush or casual blitz is a good way to get the warm up in. Also I only play chess when I feel like it. I never force myself to play because that will only end in stagnation. Whenever I practice I always try to practice with a partner who can push me to my full potential. I found out the best way to gain the most from playing games is to analyze without the computer first. The computer ends up being a crutch and if you analyze yourself it will make you understand your mistakes a whole lot better. The computer is not very good at conveying what went wrong so go through the games note what you think went wrong as well as noting what moves you should have made instead this will greatly help fix mistakes you probably didn't know even existed. Let me know if this helped.






