Tri-Creek School Corporation is applying for a waiver to increase the allowable carryover of Title I, Part A funds from 15% to 25% for the upcoming fiscal year. This waiver is part of the Educational Flexibility (Ed-Flex) Program offered by the Indiana Department of Education (IDOE), which permits local education agencies to request certain flexibilities to better address their unique needs.

Purpose of the Waiver Application

The primary goal of this waiver is to provide our district with additional time to effectively budget and allocate Title I funds that remained unspent due to unforeseen circumstances. Such circumstances include:

- **Staffing Challenges:** Unexpected resignations of Title I staff or difficulties in filling posted positions, which led to unspent allocated funds above and beyond 15%.

By increasing the carryover limit, we aim to:

- **Ensure Continuity:** Maintain and enhance educational services without the pressure of spending funds hastily at the end of the fiscal year.
- **Support Strategic Planning:** Allow for more thoughtful and effective allocation of resources to Title I programming and resources that directly benefit our students and their academic achievement and growth.
